3. Elections

5. Board Report (Skip Gordon)

- Education Act and regulations came into effect on September 1, 2019
 - Bill 8 amendments to Education Act:
 - Age of access now 19 years instead of 21 years
 - Address of student will be address of custodial parent
 - Regulation Amendments:
 - School and transportation fees have eliminated the need for reporting to/seeking approval of the Minister of Education for fees prior to them being charged to families. Fees for 2019/2020 year will be status quo
- Mackinnon Report released to the public on September 3, 2019
 - Present government isn't required to follow any of the recommendations but likely will. Many cuts were recommended (to education, health care, social programs). No details over the summer have been provided to school

boards on what to base budgets on. EIPS not expecting funding information until late October

- Organizational meeting held August 29, 2019 where Trina Boymook was once again elected to the position of Board Chair with Heather Wall elected to the position of Vice-Chair
- Policy 24 Personal Communication Devices is now in effect; the Superintendent has updated Administrative Procedure 145 to support the Board's policy
- JP questioned Skip whether the proposed updated curriculum is still a 'go' with EIPS; the reply is that at this point in time the project is on hold
